Conversation Prompts

Purpose of this film & guide

We believe God can use a piece of art to speak different things to different people. We don't want to give answers but rather stimulate ideas, dreams, questions and action.

Pray to start, watch the film and be open to how God might be speaking to you.

You're welcome to use one, all or none of these prompts on your own, in a pair or in a small group.

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1 Samuel 3:1-12

Also read the surrounding chapters for context to the Biblical character of Samuel and where he finds himself in the story.

(Keep in mind this is an Old Testament story told in the New Covenant context of the film. I'd you'd like, consider how God communicated then and how God might communicate now.)

Conversation Prompts

What aspect of the film stood out to you personally?

Why did that resonate? What other things did it bring to mind?

How familiar are you with the concept of God communicating with us?

Have you experienced this for yourself?

What does this story say about the nature of God?

What does this story say about the nature of people?

Application Prompts

Now having watched this film and had this conversation, what might you think differently about? Or what action will you take?

Set aside some time to simply *listen...*
